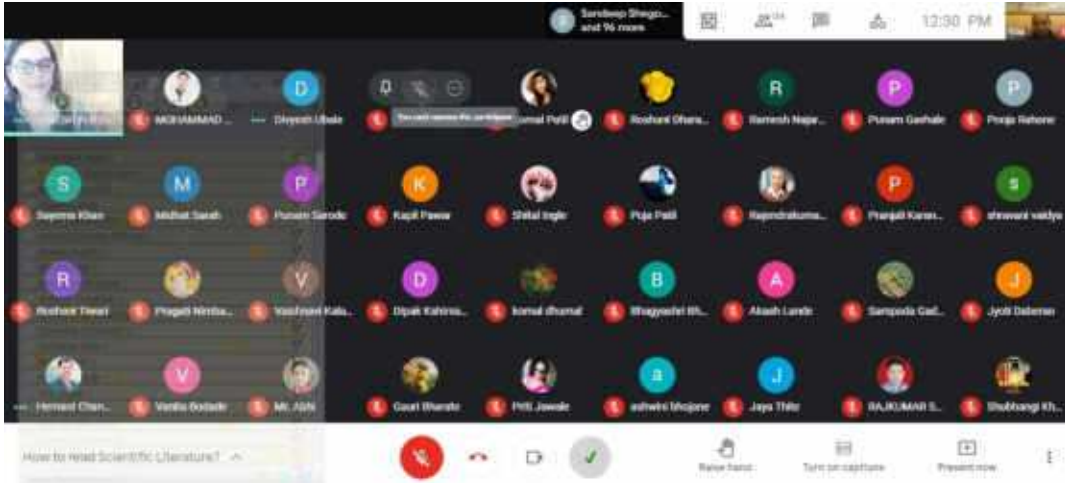

The following contents were covered in the session :

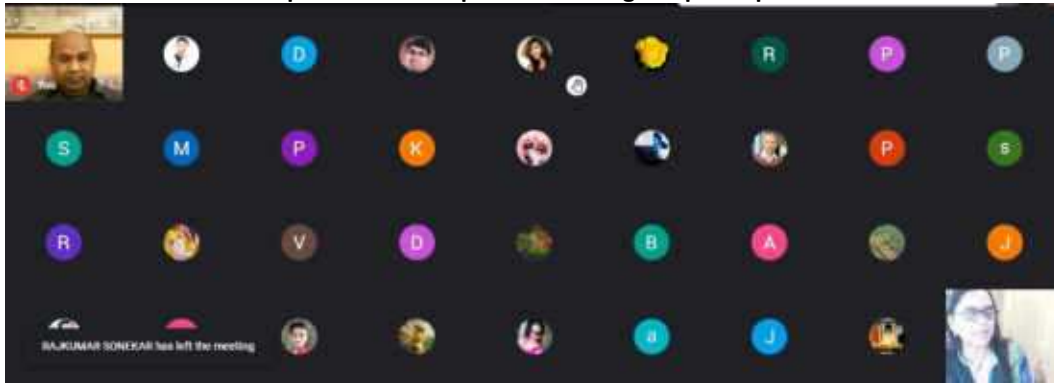
Source of literature, Curation, Importance of various parts of a research article: Title, Abstract, Introduction, Methods, Results and conclusion .
