

 4. In B.Sc. II Computer Science syllabus include the program language PHP and Python with AI and ML. Provide internship opportunities to student.



4. B.Sc. III Physics syllabus should be more application based and some numerical should be added in the syllabus



- 66.25% students are happy with security system provided by the institution.


- Suggestion

Feedback Analysis summary 2021-22

The objective of this feedback exercise is to correctly gauge the impact of all the effort taken by the institution. Our college is committed to continuous development of each and every part in educational system. So, IQAC has designed online feedback system to involve all the students to give feedback on the curriculum, infrastructure, library and teachers. IQAC conducted various surveys and sessions to seek feedback from the students on curriculum, Infrastructure, Library etc. They collect and analyze the feedback received and make suggestions to administration so as to initiate the action for improvement. The process of obtaining feedback is to get result in the involvement of relevant students in building the document and plan for the betterment of the institute.

The feedback activity includes

1. Feedback on curriculum by the student
2. Feedback on curriculum by the teachers
3. Feedback on Teachers by the students
4. Feedback on infrastructure by the students
5. Feedback on Library by the students
6. Feedback on curriculum by the employer
7. Feedback on curriculum by the Alumni

Methodology:

- Feedback on curriculum is collected from the students by uploading the Feedback Forms at the institutional website. It is collected online and brought to the IQAC for its analysis. The Statistical data is collected from the student and handed over to the Feedback committee. Further suggestions are incorporated by departments, college Council and governing body.
- Alumni feedback is collected during Alumni meeting. Feedback from teachers is collected as well by uploading the feedback forms on the portal.
- The teachers or peers also give their feedback which is available on the server and the received data gets forwarded to the authorities for further action.
- Online surveys: There was a web-based survey conducted using <https://gsck.ac.in/Gsckpro/feedback.html>
- The questionnaire had both quantitative and open-end questions.

Analysis

The feedback received from this process was used in making the document and further action plan for the institute. A summary online quantitative and qualitative (suggestions) feedback collected from students, faculty and the key findings is reported to the management during the IQAC meeting.

Key finding are as follows:

1. Industry based courses and the courses which improves the overall development of students should be introduced.

2. Special programs/ events should be organized for personality Development/soft-skills/competitive examination.
3. For the overall development of the students many of the personality programmes and softskill programs should be introduced in the institution
4. Curriculum needs to be effective.
5. New PG courses can be introduced in science faculty.

Action taken report

1. Considering the demands of the students institution has already started a short term course on social and industry
2. Institution has taken a keen effort to uplift the knowledge of the advance learners student providing more facilities from the library and also special focus is made on the slow learner students providing them a remedial coaching.
3. Bridge Courses and skill oriented courses have been introduced to bridge the knowledge gap and to make students more skilled.
4. Placement and guidance cell has been strengthened. Many personality programmes and also softskillprogrammes are arranged by the placement cell for the benefit of the student.
5. Teachers are asked to undertake more experiential teaching learning process. Teachers are also using PowerPoint presentations for enhancing teaching learning experience.
6. To help undergraduate fresh students understand the challenges and opportunities present in the Institute and to counsel their academic and personal problems 'Students Mentoring System' is introduced. Also Students induction program as governed by the SGBAU is also introduced for the fresher students. In this program a various program like know your college, Various renowned lectures from the various expert is being introduced.
7. Various short term courses which are helpful for the beneficial of students are introduced.
8. New PG programme M.Sc. Mathematics is also introduced by the institution to give more knowledge to student.
